COVID'19 GUIDE LINES

1. Entry in campus is allowed after disinfecting procedure and thermal screening. Parents are very humbly requested to avoid entry in campus under this situation.
2. It is mandatory to wear fresh/new mask and gloves at the time of entry. Mask used during travel will be disposed off in pedal operated dustbin.
3. Identity card is mandatory for entry on main gate.
4. Entry of day scholar at COER main gate will be allowed not later than 40 minutes before the commencement of examination.
5. Submission of hard copy of the undertaking (self declaration), as format given UTU Dehradun duly signed by parents is essential.
6. Installation of '**Arogya Setu Application**' is mandatory for all students.
7. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
8. Shaking hands or hugging for greeting each other be avoided.
9. Clean your hands with 60% alcohol based sanitizer or soap and water frequently.
10. Students are not allowed to visit room of classmate in hostel.
11. Students are required to go directly to his/her examination hall. After completion, students are required to return directly to their place of stay. Social distancing and COVID'19 precautions are mandatory. Movement in campus without essential reason is restricted.
12. Students will not be allowed for going outside the campus after arriving on the venue of examination.
13. Students are required to keep patience and remain calm in examination hall.

Note :

1. Those students who are unable to appear in the examinations due to COVID-19 related reasons will be provided another opportunity to appear in examination by the University after the COVID-19 situation becomes normal.
2. All inbound students, teachers, parents and their associates coming for appearing in examinations of the student from other states or from other districts of Uttarakhand shall mandatorily register themselves on the Smart City web portal <http://smartcitydehradun.uk.gov.in> prior to their travel.*
